IT IS LITERALLY FEAST OR FAMINE FOR OUR DESERT HONEYBEES, SO TO HELP THEM AND OTHER NATIVE SPECIES, BY PLANTING FOR OUR DEARTH PERIODS. THIS IS WHEN THERE IS A SCARCITY OR LACK OF FOOD: SUMMER AND WINTER. THE POLLINATORS NEED YOUR HELP TO PROVIDE A SAFE, PESTICIDE FREE FORAGE AREA IN THEIR TIME OF NEED.**
